

Present perfect with *ever / never*

Have you **ever been** to the Olympics? Yes, I **have**. / No, I **haven't**.

I've seen the boxing. **I've never won** a race.

see – **seen**

eat – **eaten**

win – **won**

do – **done**

break – **broken**

sleep – **slept**

ride – **ridden**

go – **gone**

**Possessives**

It's **my** sweater. It's **mine**.

It's **his** sweater. It's **his**.

It's **our** sweater. It's **ours**.

It's **your** sweater. It's **yours**.

It's **her** sweater. It's **hers**.

It's **their** sweater. It's **theirs**.

**Past continuous**

I **was reading** a book.

She **was sleeping** on the sofa.

We **were playing** tennis.

You **were driving** to work.

He **was standing** on the balcony.

They **were playing** football.

**Object pronouns**

Give **me** your hand.

Invite **her** to the party.

Show **them** the book.

Pass **him** the camera.

Take **us** to the fountain.

**Who / Which / Where**

Mr Reid is the man **who** teaches us Science.

London is the city **where** I was born.

Skateboarding is the sport **which** I like best.
