Going to; ordinal numbers 11-31

This year the **21**st (twenty-first) of May is going to be a Monday.

The **22nd** (twenty-second) of May is going to be a Tuesday.

The **23rd (twenty-third)** of May is going to be a Wednesday.

The **24th** (twenty-fourth) of May is going to be a Thursday.

The **25th (twenty-fifth)** of May is going to be a Friday.



Connectors; went + ing

I looked into the water, **but** I didn't see the fish.

We went to a lake **and** we had a picnic there.

I went swimming because the water was warm.



Could / Couldn't

When I was young 40 years ago I **could jump** higher than a tree.

The **heaviest** dinosaur was **heavier than** 17 African elephants.
