

- 1 Listen to the dialogue. Then work with a partner. Read the dialogue again and again until your teacher tells you to stop. Each time you start again, change roles.
 - A: Where are you from?
 - B: I'm from L.A.
 - A: Los Angeles?
 - B: Yeah.* I'm a famous actor.
 - A: Really?
 - B: Yeah. I'm Leonardo / Angelina.
 - A: Dicaprio? / Jolie?
 - B: Yeah.
 - A: No way!*
 - * Yeah /jeə/ means 'Yes'.
 - * No way! means 'I don't believe you'.
- 2 Read the dialogue again, but this time a bit faster. When you begin to remember what to say, look into your partner's eyes.
- 3 Put the paper down. Act out the dialogue as a scene. What is the situation? Who are these people? Try to move and make expressions with your face and body. Really act it out!
