


Simple past, regular verbs

jump – jumped shout – shouted

land – landed look at – looked at

I was so hungry. Great, spaghetti – yummy! Suddenly the dog jump**ed** onto the table. 'Go away, silly dog!' I shout**ed**. The plate land**ed** on the floor. Now the dog was next to the spaghetti. He look**ed** at the spaghetti.



Simple past, irregular verbs

wake up – woke up feel – felt have – had

go – went give – gave say – said

Last Friday, Lily, the lolly monster woke up at half past eight.

She **felt** awful. She **had** a terrible stomach-ache. She **went** to the hospital.

The doctor **gave** her a pink, a red and a blue pill. Lily **said**, 'Can I have a lolly?

I really don't like pills!' 'I'm sorry,' the doctor **said**, 'No lolly for you!'



Negatives with simple past

I went to the beach, but I didn't go swimming.

He played basketball, but he **didn't play** football.

She saw a lion, but she **didn't see** a monkey.



Questions and answers with simple past

Did you go shopping?

Did you **see** the Statue of Liberty?

When did you get home?

Yes, I did.

No, I didn't.

Yesterday.



Future with going to + infinitive

I'm **going to sit** in the garden.

I'm not going to cook pizza.

It's **going to be** rainy.

It's not going to be sunny.



Questions and answers with going to + infinitive

Are you going to play lots of football?

Yes, I am.

Are you **going to watch** TV?

No, I'm not.
