I'm **good at** doing experiments.
She's **good at** riding bikes.

I'm **not good at** climbing trees.
He's **not good at** flying kites.



Possessive apostrophe

Oliver is Alex's **uncle**.
Alex is Bob's **grandson**.

Paul and Molly are Alex's **cousins**.
Lisa is Alex's **aunt**.



Like / Don't like + ing

I **like** singing.
He **loves** learning about Science.

She really **doesn't like** dancing.



Have to + infinitive

You **have to wear** school uniform.
You **have to do** your homework.
You **don't have to read** two books every week.



What's the matter? + adjectives

What's the matter?
What's the matter with Conner?
What's the matter with Mrs Harvey?

I'm **tired**.
He's **ill**.
She's **busy**.



Should / Shouldn't

I'm **tired**. You **should** go to bed.
I'm **scared**. You **shouldn't** watch horror films.
